In his current exhibit at Agora Gallery in New York, Gideon Goodash's works combine painting, collage, and photography. The framing device for his images? A series of weathered walls and abandoned rooms captured with his camera. With a keen eye for light, texture and color, he gives each space a powerful physical presence, creating environments in which the ghosts of past inhabitants are felt.

The element of collage comes in through the use of other images by the artist, which he places in each space as if hanging them in a personal gallery. That second level of imagery animates each work, creating a sense of contrast and energy. Goodash (also known as Gideon Spiegel) lives and works in Tel Aviv.
