**Doha-based artist's works displayed at NY gallery** 

Doha-based artist Jennifer Pinder's artworks have received international acclaim at one of the world's exclusive commercial galleries.

Agora Gallery, based in New York but with galleries across the United States, has selected Pinder's work to be represented by them and hosted her first North American exhibition in February 2012.

Four of her pieces are on display in the gallery's Chelsea, New York art space.

Up until her move to Qatar in 2009, Pinder enjoyed a long standing association with the prestigious Australian gallery, the Libby Edwards Galleries (Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane) exhibiting her works as well as handling commissions for high profile clients.

In January 2011, Pinder held her first Middle East-based exhibition, Unique Perspectives at the art space at the Grand Hyatt Doha. In April 2012, Pinder's works will be shown at the Trevisan International Art exhibition. The show, Liberated Dreams is the Italian gallery's annual International Art Exhibition and will be held at the Imbarcadero Rooms of the beautiful Estense Castle of Ferrara in Northern Italy.

Pinder brings her unique perspective to her home in Qatar and has drawn on her reaction to the landscape and architecture that surrounds her for her most recent works. Her medium is oil on canvas and are large pieces stretching 150cms by 150cms. "This is a remarkable opportunity for me to expose my works to a broader audience in the US and Europe," Pinder said. "Agora Gallery has represented some of the most significant contemporary artists since it opened its doors in 1994 and it's an honour for me to be included in this list and it is also significant for me to have this kind of high level representation in the US. "

Pinder is currently working on pieces for a new exhibition scheduled for late 2012 in Doha.
