

Stouffville artist's work going up in New York City this summer

Stouffville's Vicky Talwar will have her work exhibited in New York City starting later this month.

Talwar's original work will be featured, along with seven other artists, in the show entitled Idiosyncratic Expressions. It runs from July 31 to Aug. 20 at the Agora Gallery in Chelsea, New York.

Talwar has had her work in Latcham Gallery's 2014 show Home, 2012's Big Night Out with Bollywood and the annual juried show in 2005 and 2006.

Her vibrant floral paintings often resemble textiles in their stunning detail and her palette examines and celebrates the cultural contexts of flowers as well as their ornate qualities, according to the media release.

Talwar's compositions also achieve abstract patterns, teeming with vitality, that spring off in different directions, spellbinding the viewer.

Idiosyncratic Expressions presents subjects and themes from the past, present and future in an exhibition of nostalgia and re-imagination.
